



INSTRUCTIONS

STORAGE

- Always store flat in a dry environment

USE

Your pedestal FlowerCage comprises of a pedestal cage and a pedestal cone.

- **Cone**

- Tip: For ease of use place cone in a flower bucket**

- Line cone with cellophane
 - Pack with Oasis foam
 - Fill cone with water and allow oasis to soak
 - Once Oasis has taken up enough water pour off excess water, this keeps the weight down
 - With the cone still in the flower bucket, make your display (you can transport it like this too.)

- **FlowerCage**

- Tip: The Flowercage requires two people to put it into the pedestal shape**

- With one person holding the cage at either the top or the bottom stitch and a second person holding the cage at the other stitch line twist the cage in opposite directions. I.e. one person twists clockwise the other anti-clockwise. This is most easily achieved on a smooth floor. When using on a carpeted floor take care not to catch the rods of the cage

- **Placing the Cone in the FlowerCage**

- Take cone, if heavy this may require two people, gently part the FlowerCage at any point and with the cone upright place in centre of FlowerCage aperture
 - If the cone is lop-sided simply adjust the cone to sit upright
 - Now with the cone in place go around the base of the FlowerCage adjusting the rods so that they are all of an even splay. This will happen automatically on a smooth, slippery floor but on a carpeted or vinyl floor you will need to assist the FlowerCage to find its resting place.

- **Load Weight**

- The cage is made of 40 9mm dia. hard wood rods and can take a maximum load of 10 Kilos (including the cone.)
 - Please do exercise common sense when filling the cone with water. Remember that one litre of water weighs 1 kilo and the cone capacity is approx 6.5 litres. That's over a stone of weight in old measures!
